



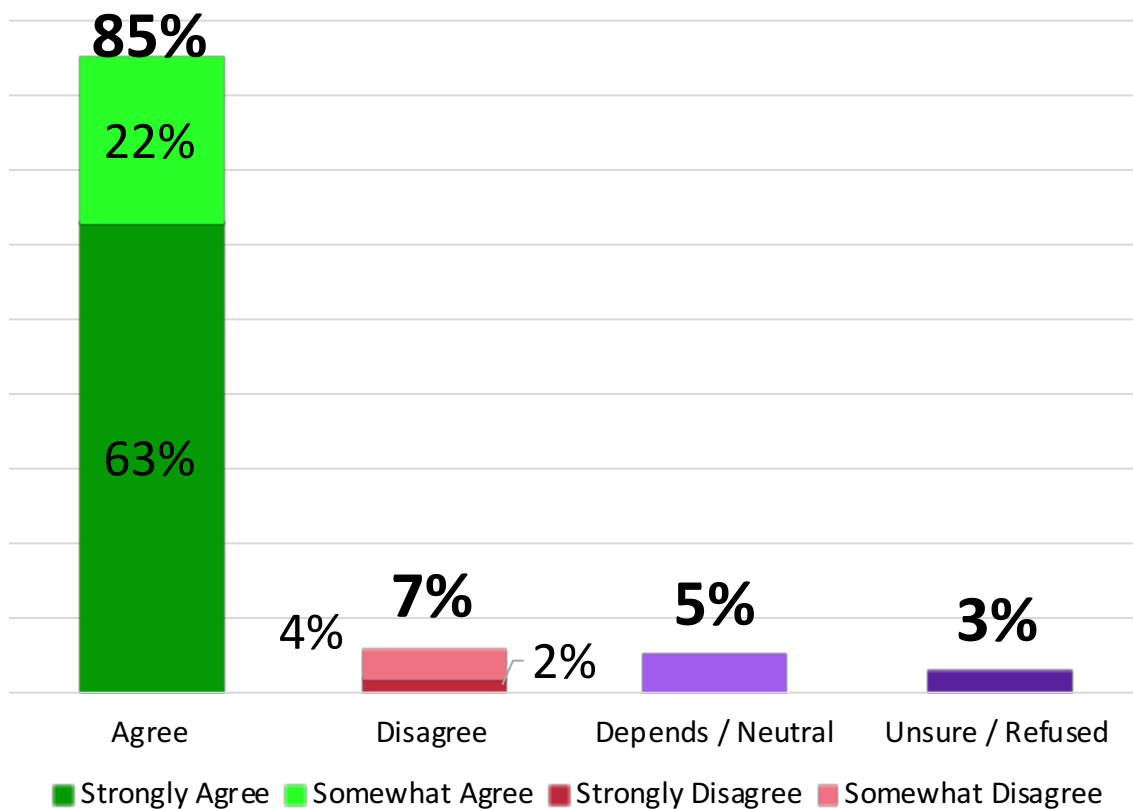

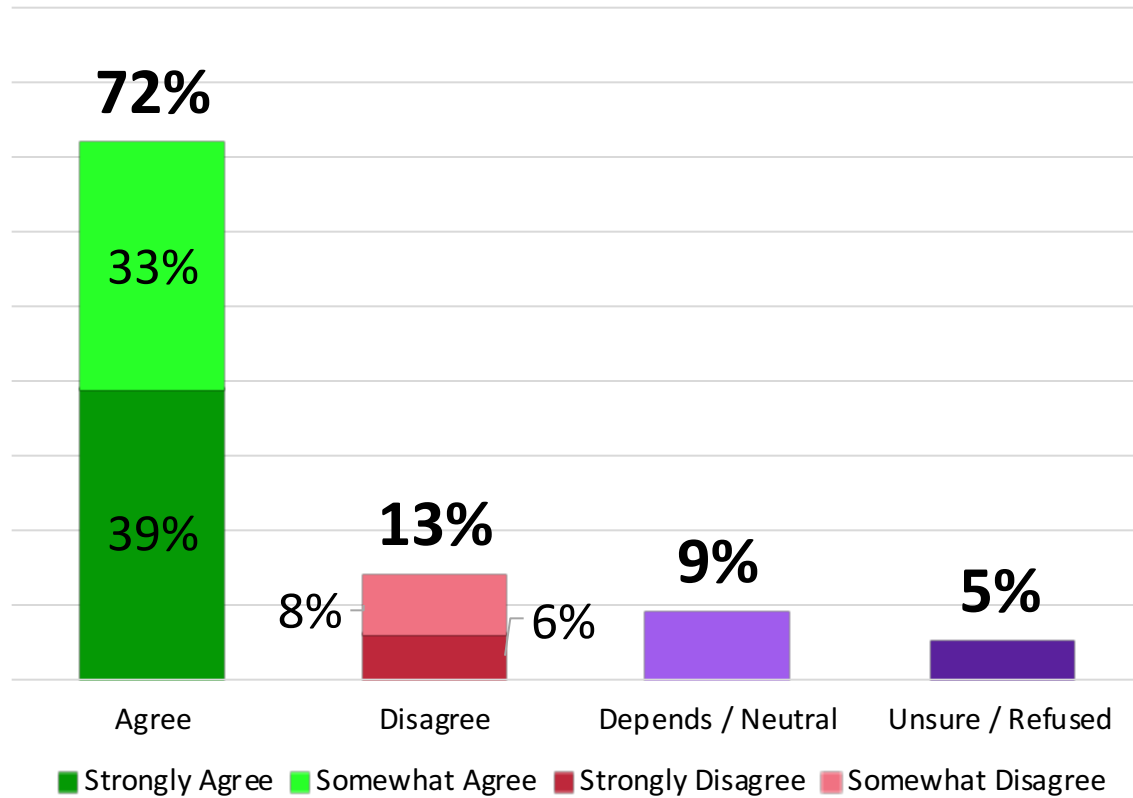

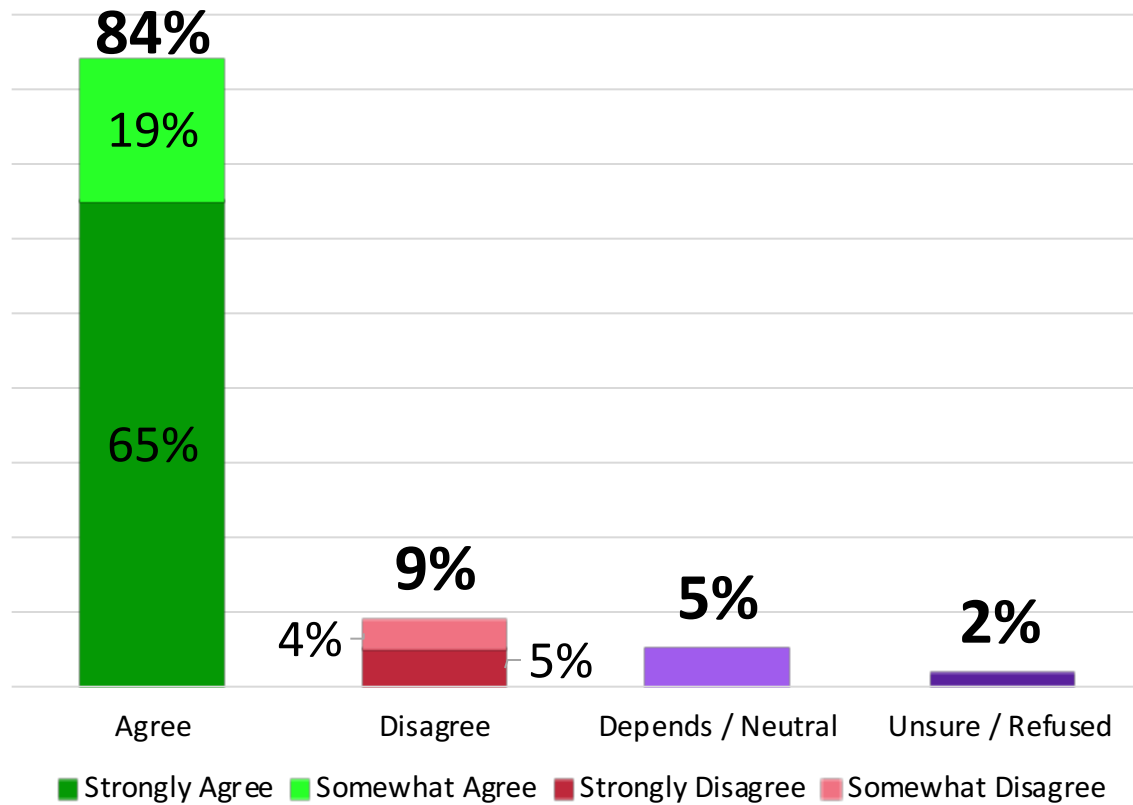

Do you agree or disagree that strong safeguards and ballot protections inspire confidence by making it harder to hide fraud, and easier to dispel false allegations of fraud?



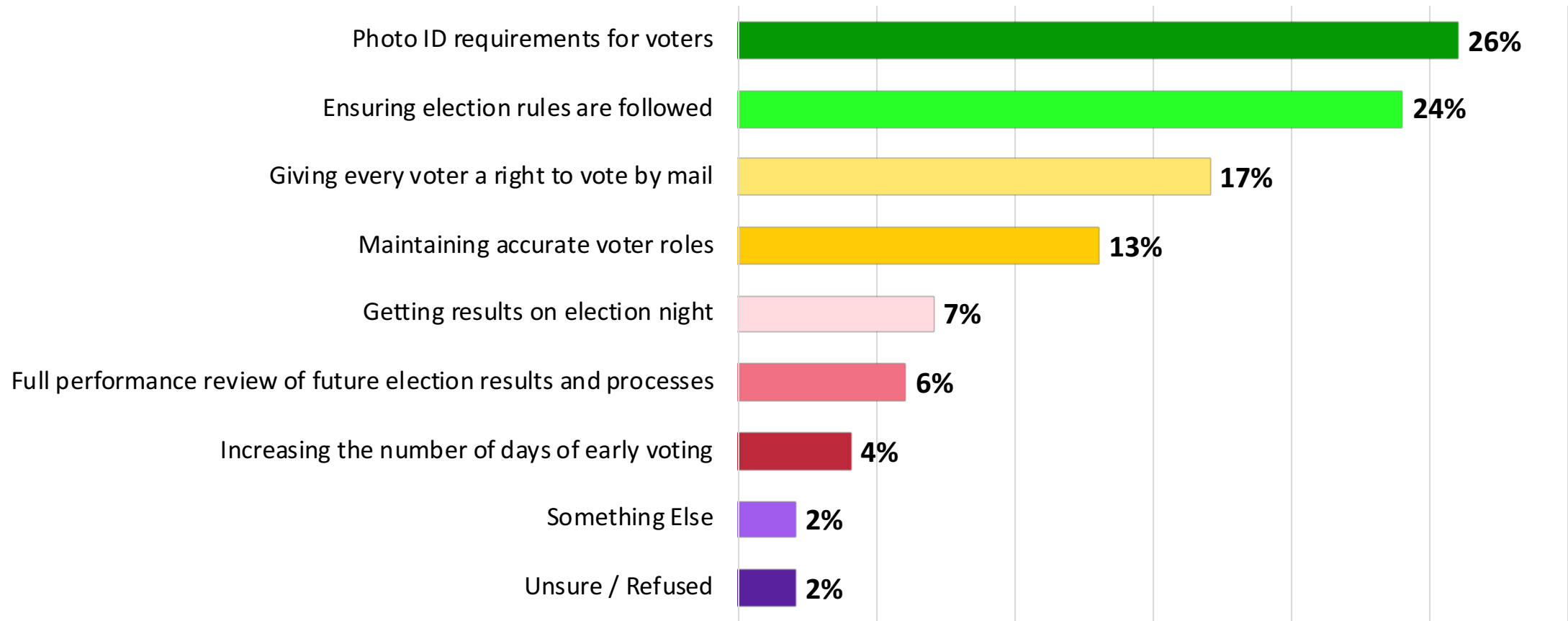

Do you agree or disagree that voters should be required to show a photo ID when they vote?

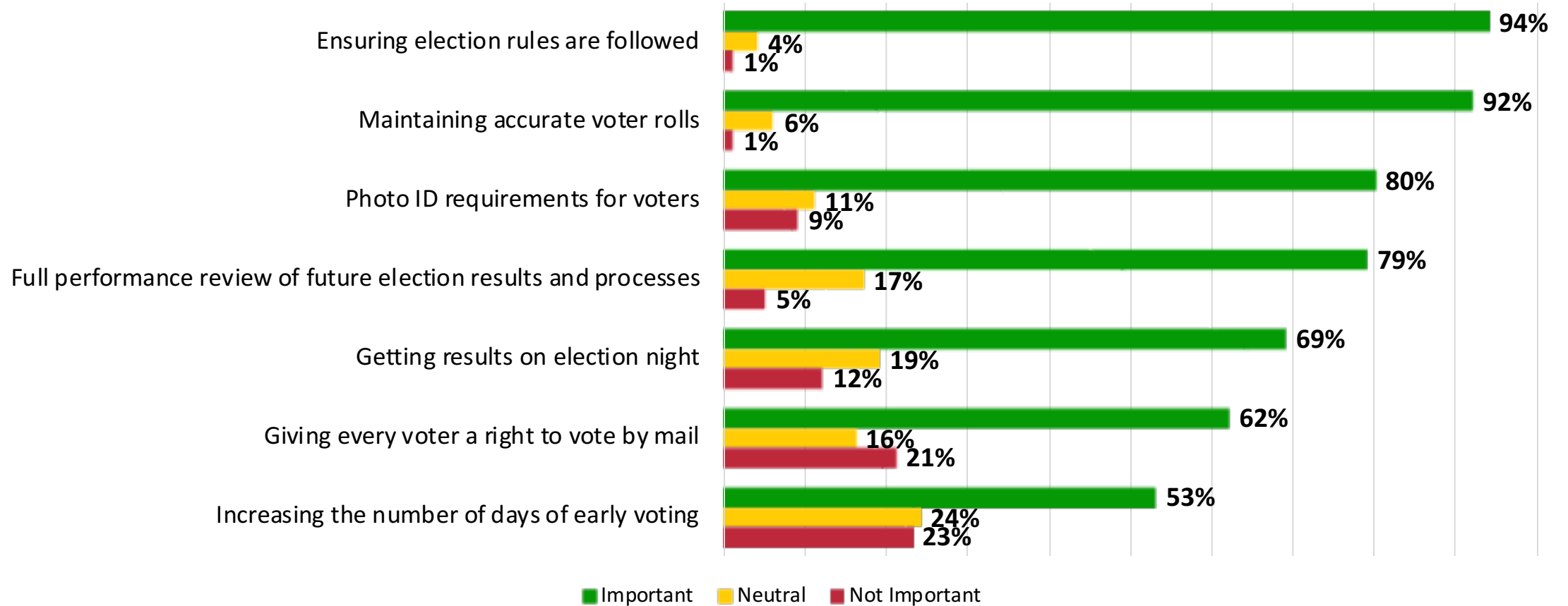

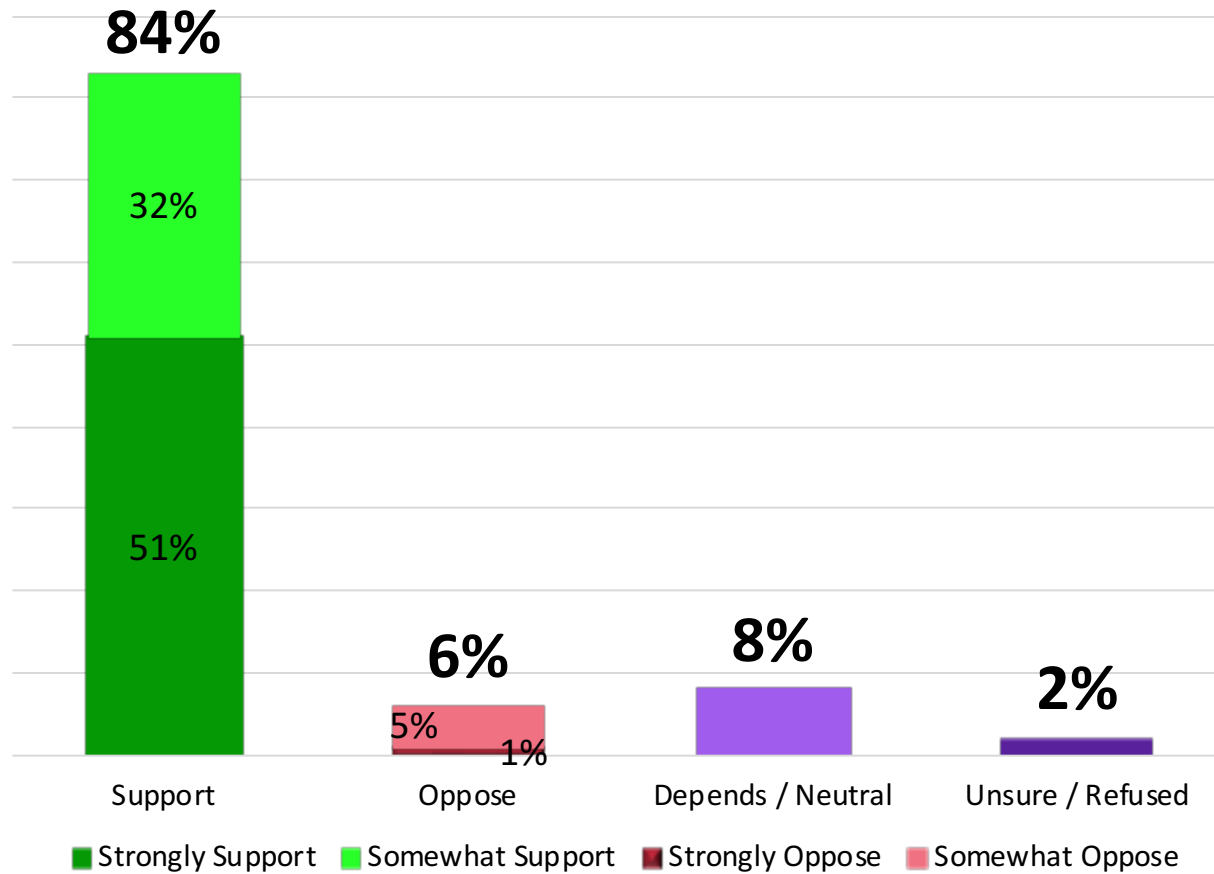
Thinking about elections, which of the following is the most important issue?



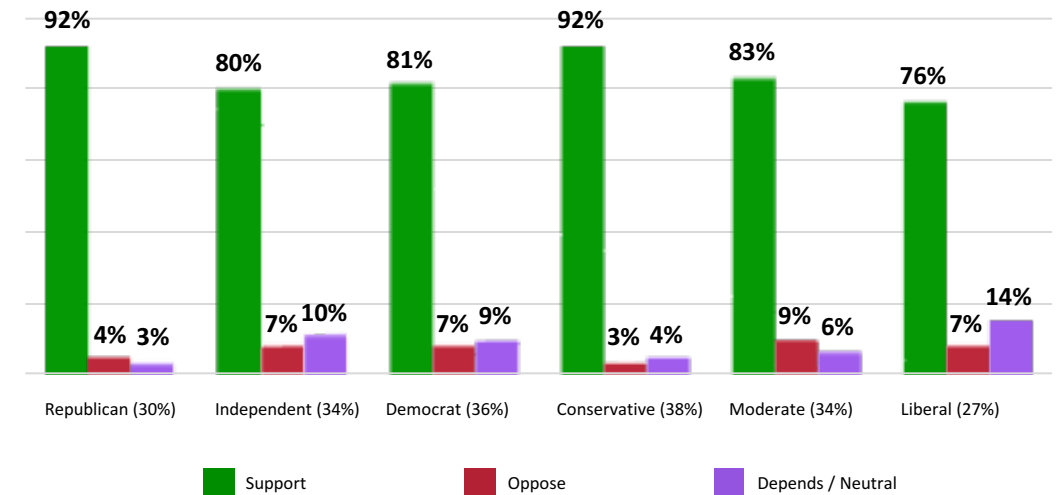

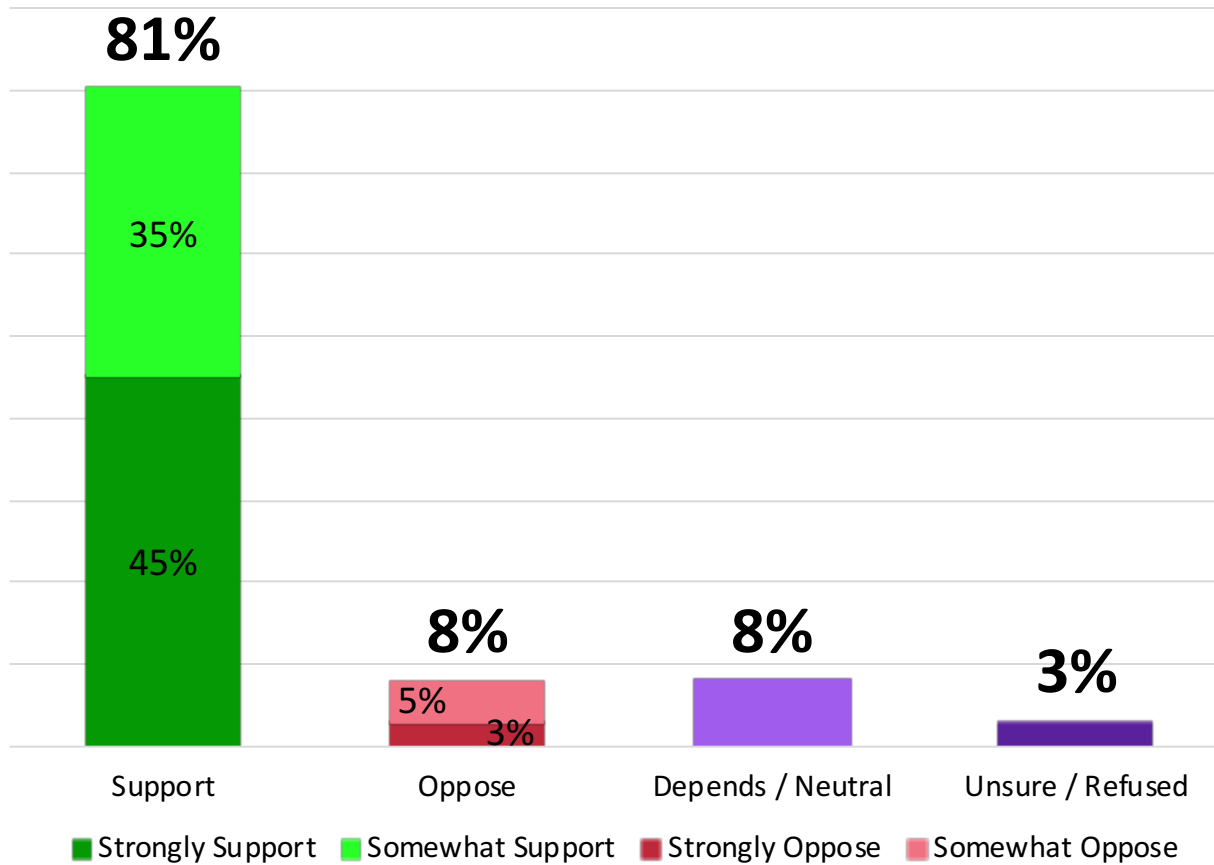
Do you support or oppose a requirement that states double-check vote counts before the election results are certified, such as a spot check or statistical analysis, to ensure there are no errors in the results?



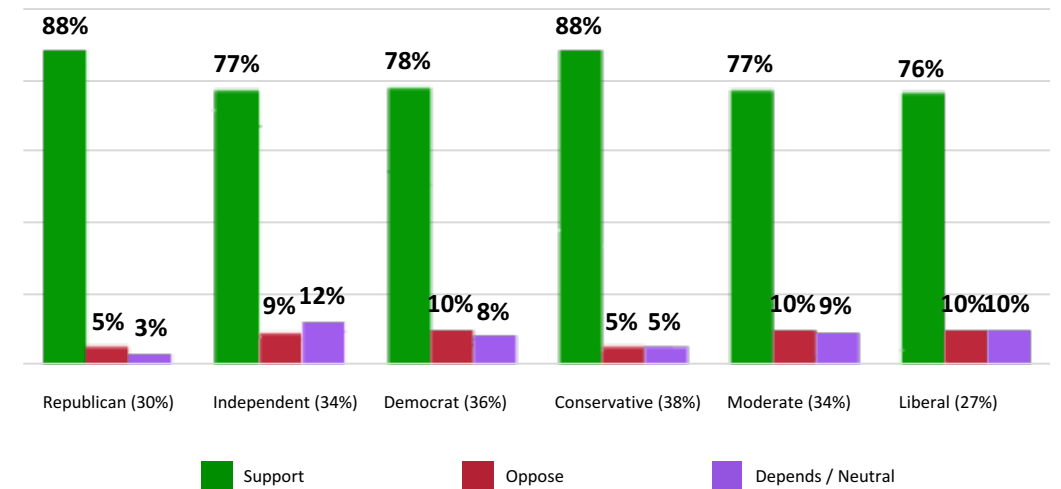
Confirming Vote Counts by Key Demographics



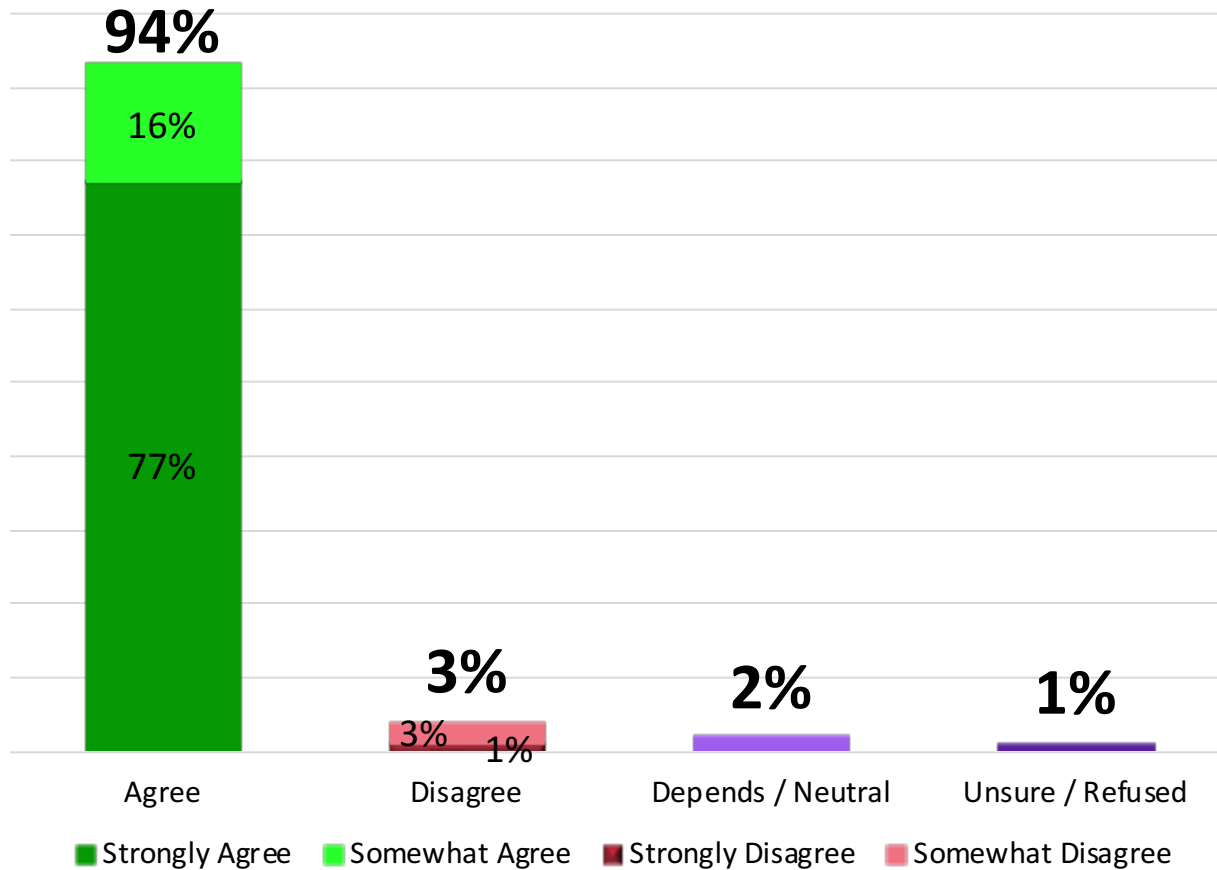
Do you support or oppose every election office undergoing a full performance review of election results and processes by a third-party at least once every four (4) years?



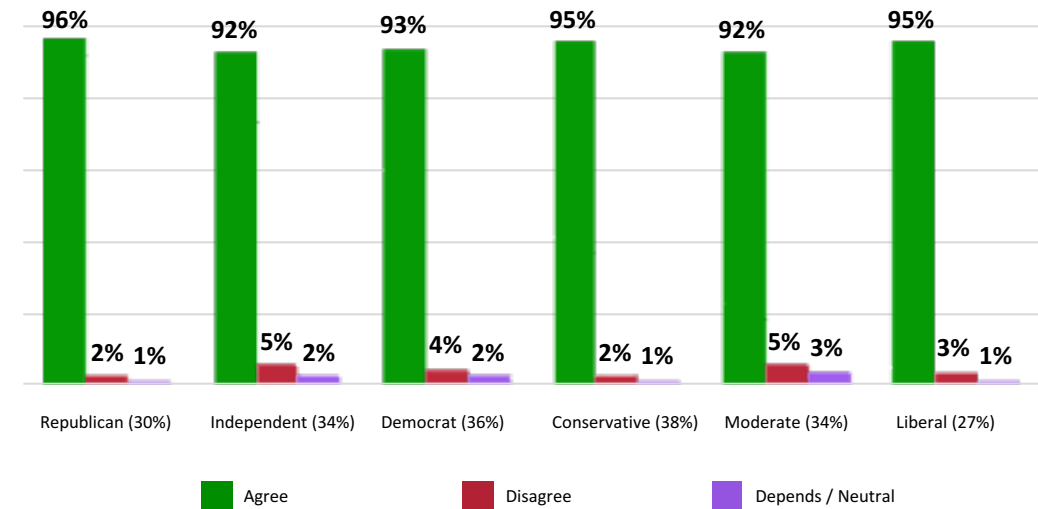
Election Audits by Key Demographics



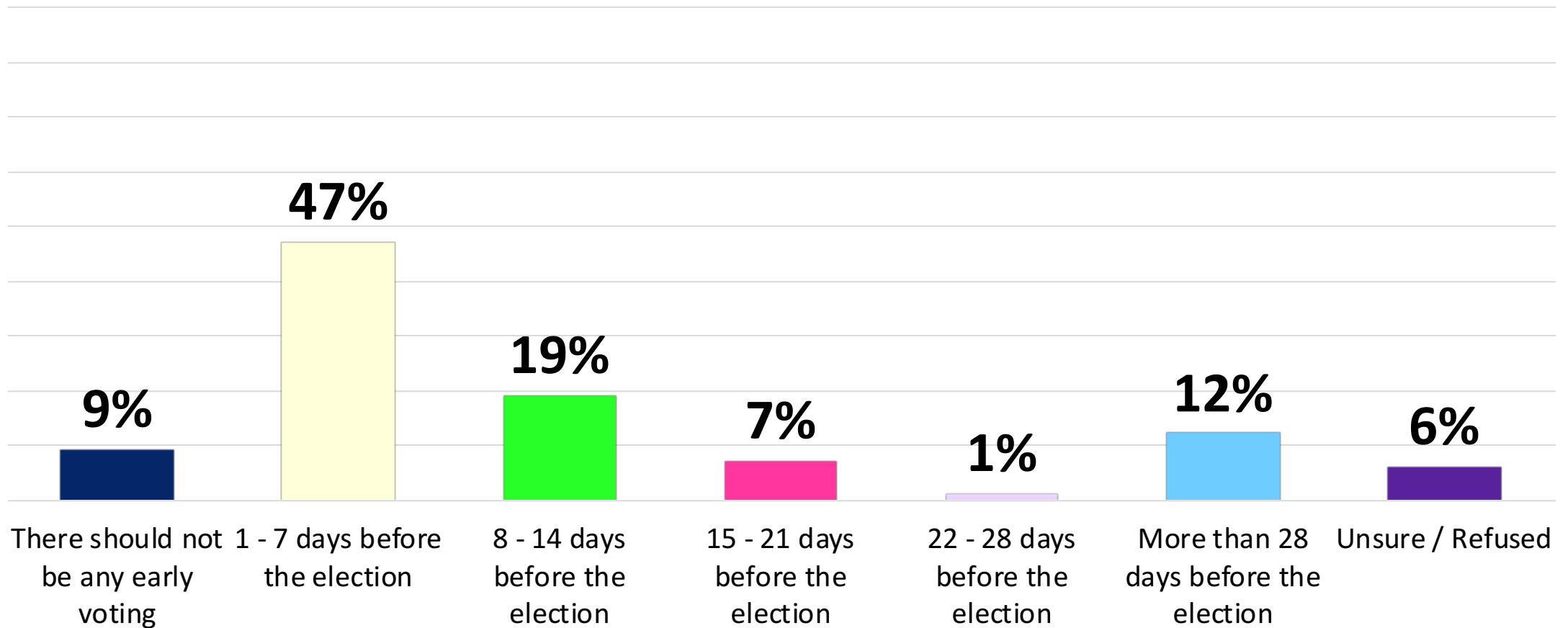
Do you agree or disagree that public officials who break elections laws should be punished?



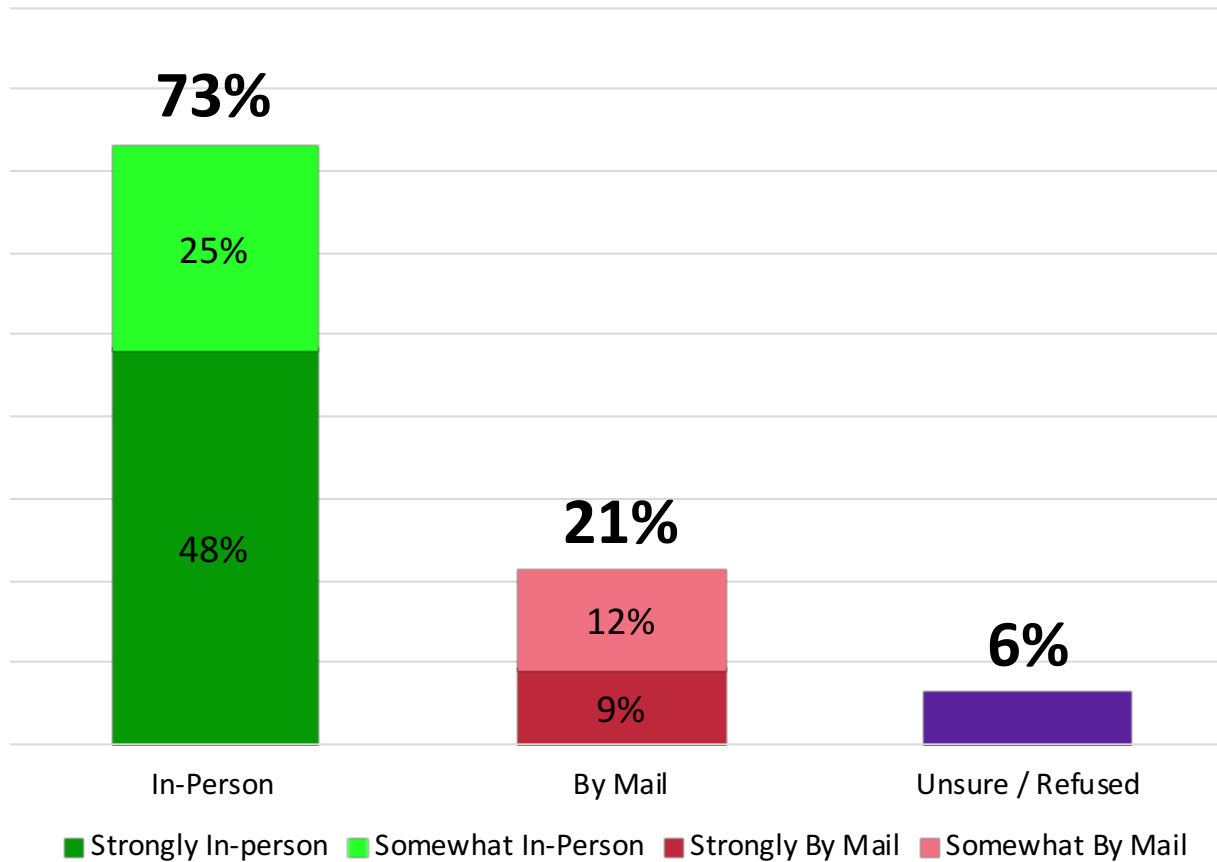
Punishing Public Officials by Key Demographics



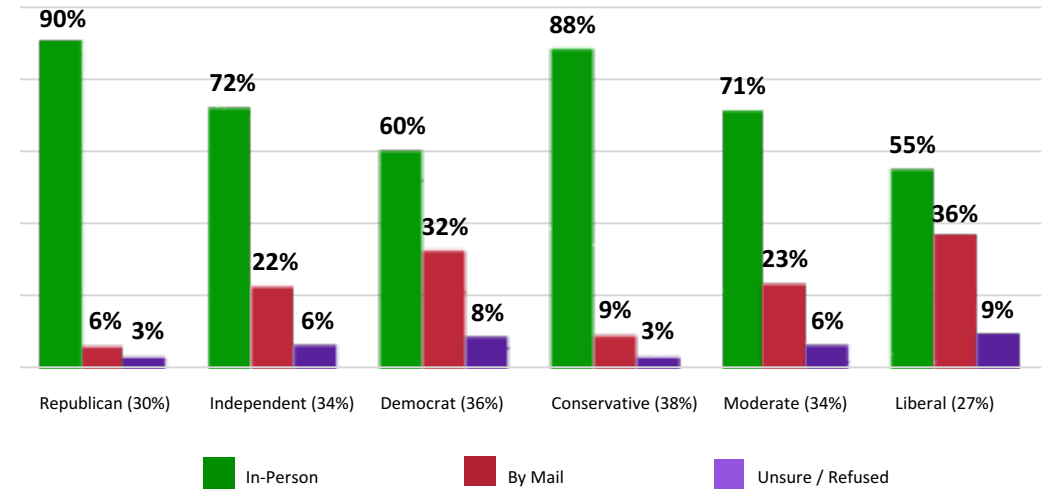
How many days before Election Day should people be able to vote early in person, if any?



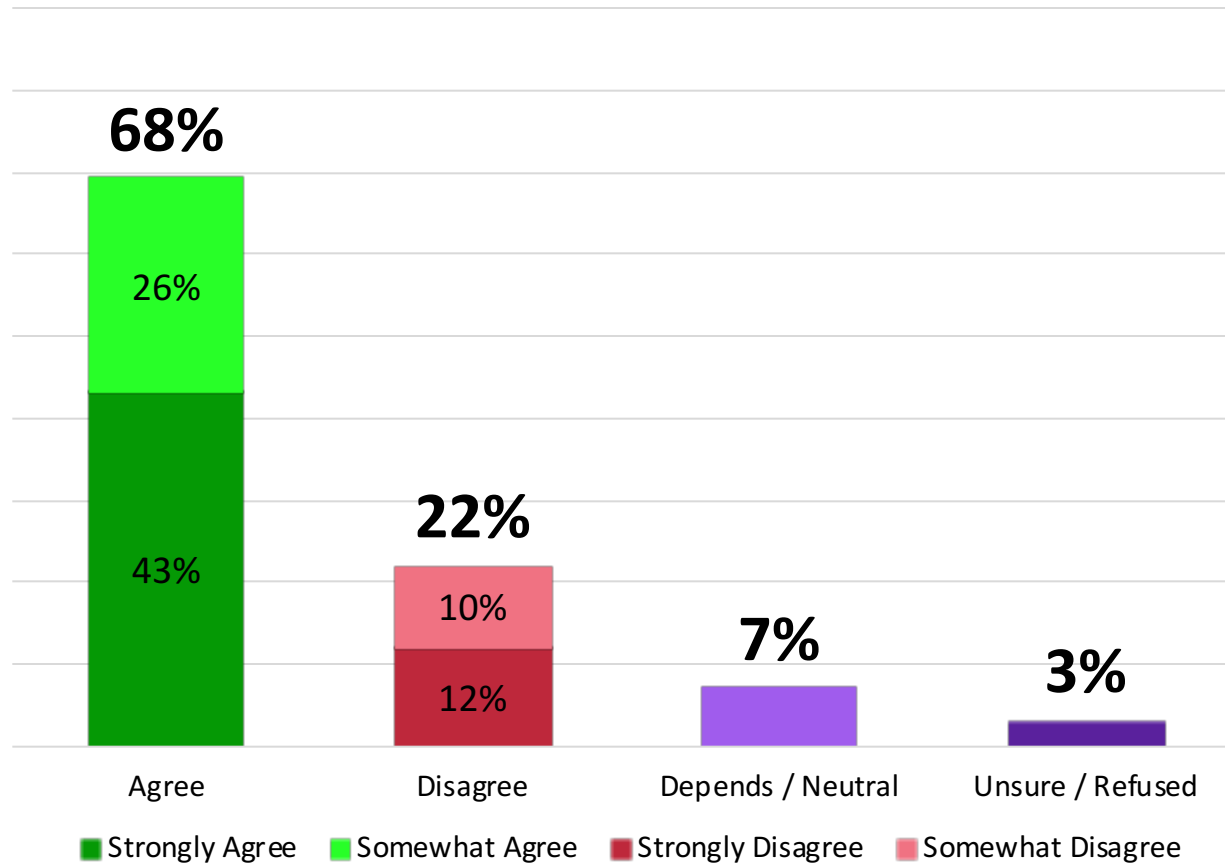
Do you think it would be better for people to vote in-person or by mail?



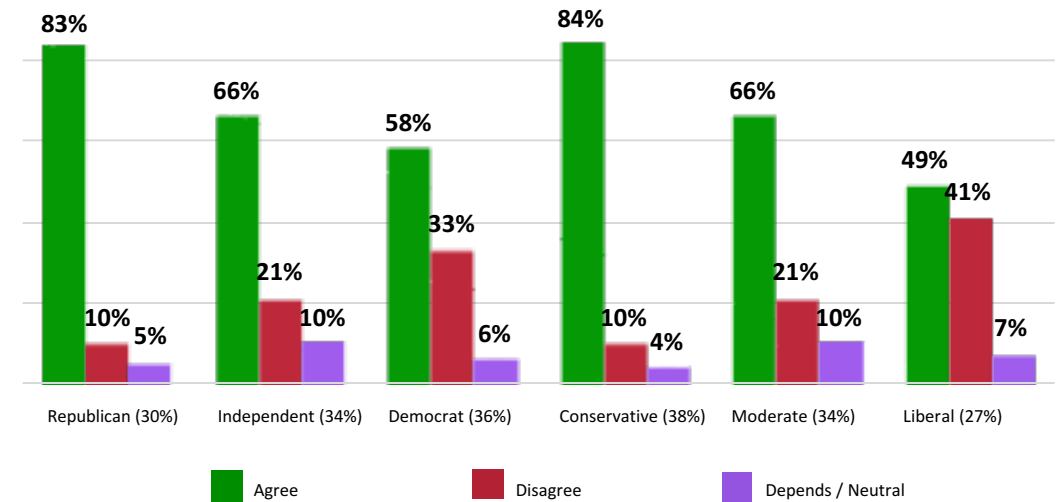
Voting Preferences by Key Demographics



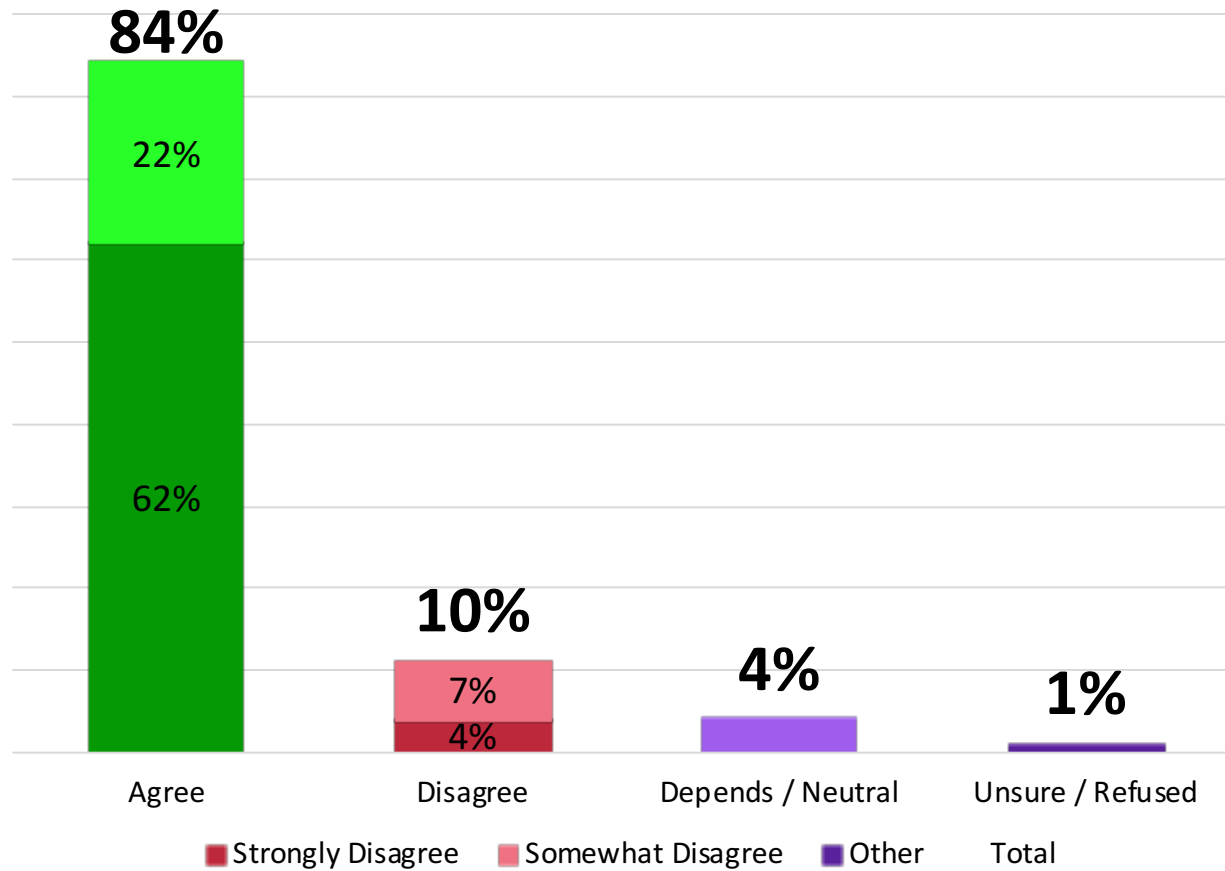
If a voter wishes to vote by mail, do you agree or disagree that the voter should have to request a ballot, as opposed to the state automatically sending out ballots for every election?



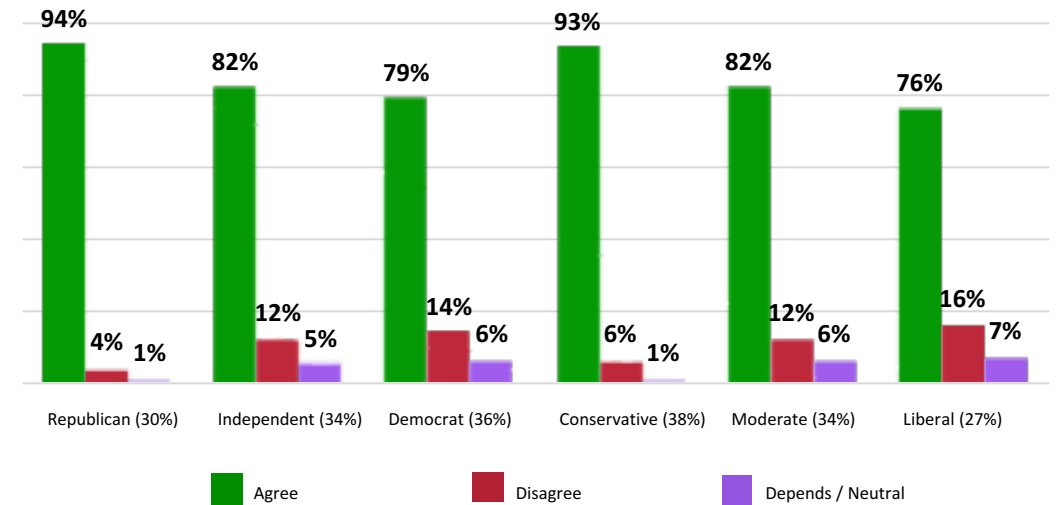
Voting Request Ballots by Key Demographics



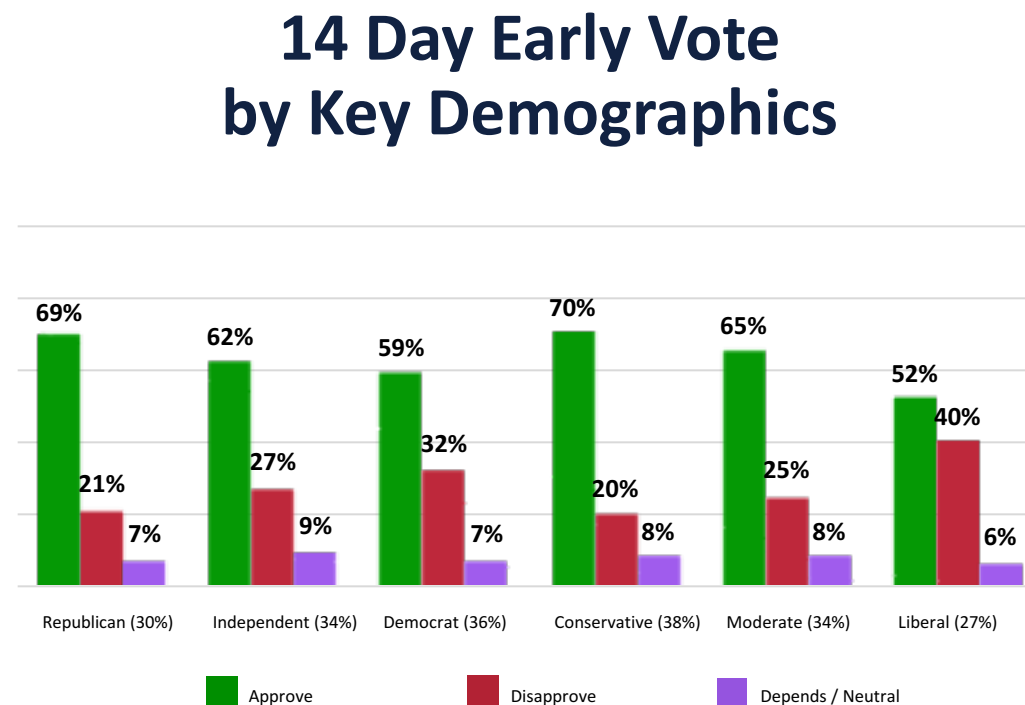
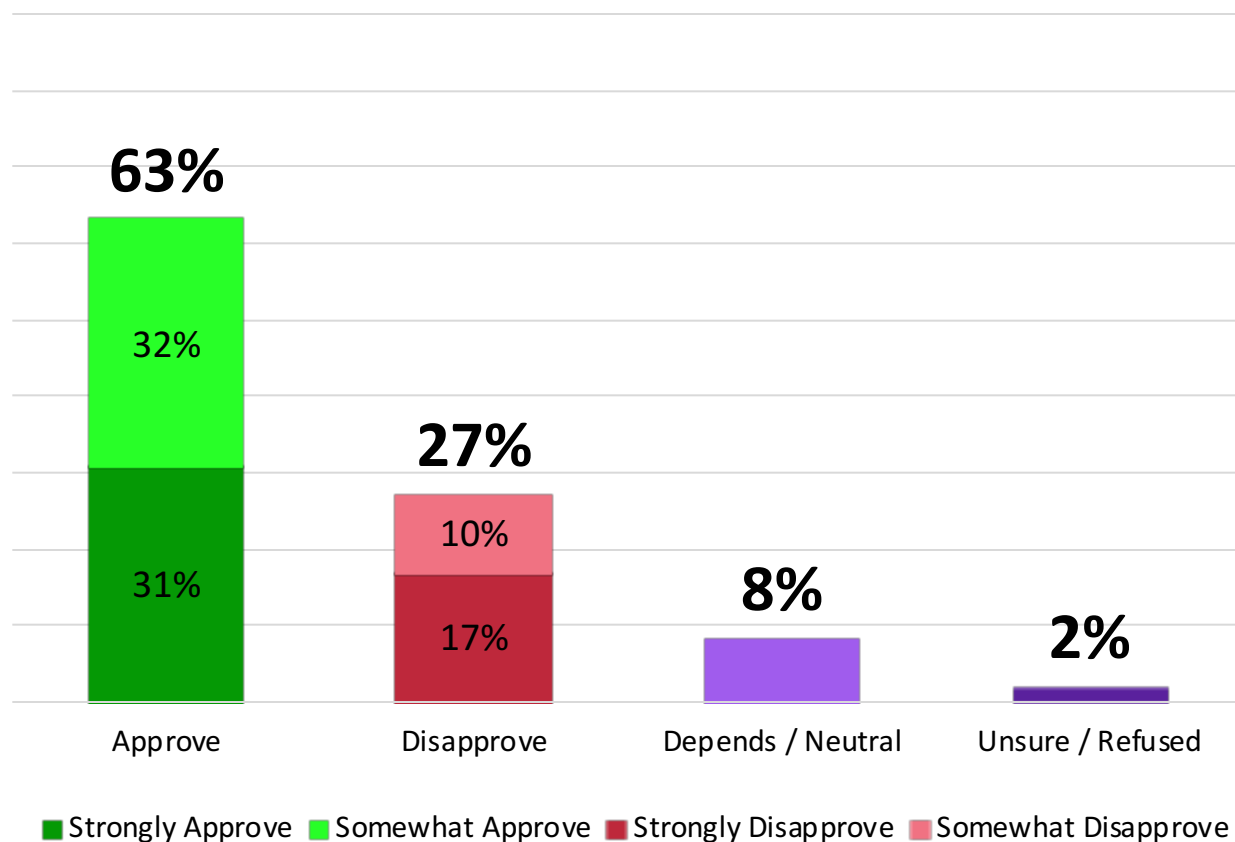
Do you agree or disagree that ballots should be received by Election Day?



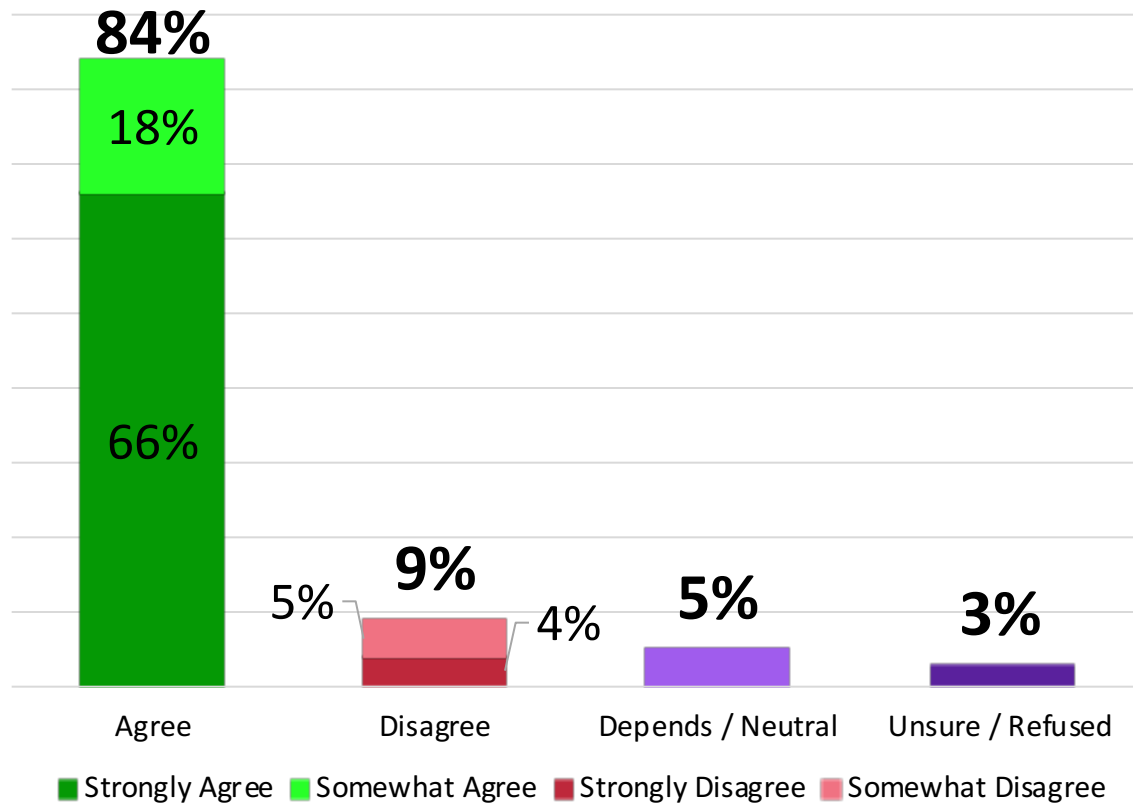
Ballots Received by Election Day by Key Demographics
