HOW A PIPELINE OF FOREIGN CASH IMPACTS TEXAS POLITICS

- Foreign nationals are prohibited from contributing to candidates directly, but there is no federal or Texas law prohibiting foreign nationals from contributing directly or indirectly to ballot issue campaigns.
- The Washington, D.C. based Sixteen Thirty Fund is a dark money behemoth that has taken \$280 million from a foreign billionaire named Hansjorg Wyss.
- Hansjörg Wyss, a Swiss billionaire who is not an American citizen, has stated his goal is to "(re)interpret the American Constitution in the light of progressive politics," and has contributed over a quarter of a billion dollars to Sixteen Thirty Fund.
- The Sixteen Thirty Fund has spent almost \$130 million on ballot issue campaigns in 25 states to usher in liberal policies, including \$100,000 to a campaign that opposed a ballot issue to increase police in Austin.
- State and local ballot measures should NEVER be a Trojan Horse for foreign interference in American elections.
